Call at the right time of day or night.  
Don't intrude if they are busy.

Have a reserve of topics to talk about.  
Introduce the subject of God's love for all.  
Join in, when possible, with their personal interests.  
Keep from gossiping.

Make use of the Bible, and always have it in your hand  
Never argue with the prospect.  
Operate under the direction of the Spirit.  
Pray as you visit.  
Quiet their fears and misapprehensions  
Radiate the love of Christ.  
Speak well of church, pastor, and others.  
Talk enthusiastically of your Sabbath school.  
Understand and be patient with their personal problems:  
Vital personal witness is your best weapon.  
Watch the clock - Don't stay too long.  
"Xpect" unpleasant responses and unkind remarks sometimes.  
You may be Christ's only witness to them -- do your best.
